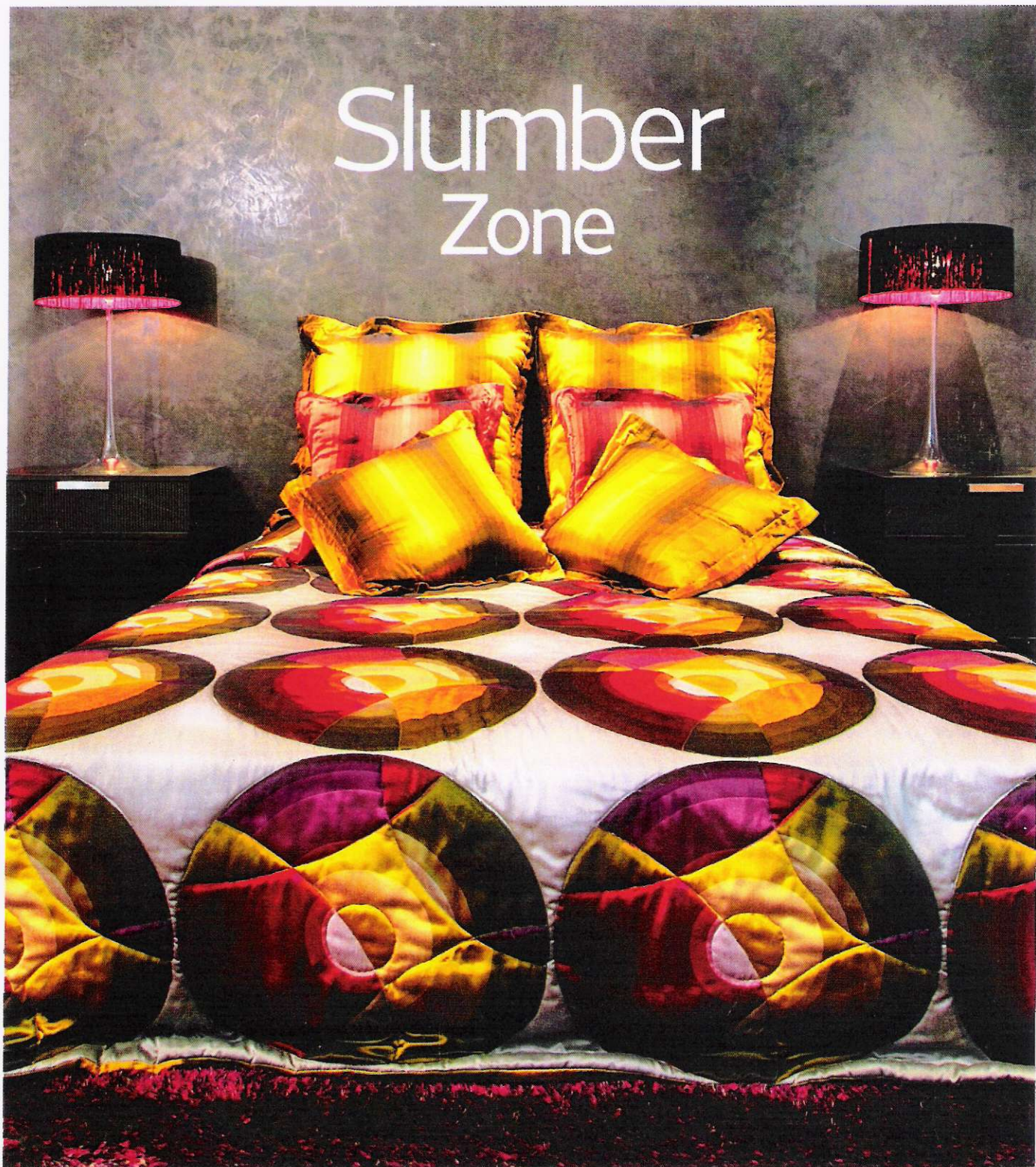

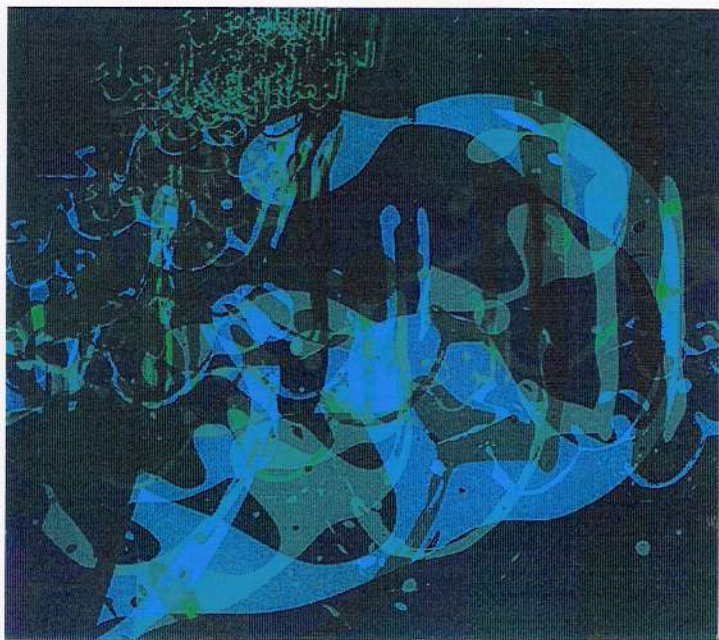
War Stories

Paris-based Iranian painter Ghass Rouzkhoss addresses some rather poignant contemporary, cultural and geopolitical issues in his latest works, currently exhibited at the B21 Gallery. In tackling complex questions and referring to his personal experiences as a soldier during the devastating Iran-Iraq war, Ghass limits himself to three symbolic colours - red, black and white - and adds a three-dimensional touch by incorporating the picture frame into the paintings. Ever the purveyors of unique, truly original artists and artworks, B21 excels with their latest show of dark, brooding canvases that were surreal but utterly enveloping.
